# CUSTOMS DUTY RATE RATIONALISATION/CHANGES VIDE BUDGET 2022 PROPOSALS 

February, 2022


Vide the Finance Bill 2022, the Customs duty exemptions for various products have been comprehensively reviewed and about 350 exemptions were withdrawn, while there are increases in duty rates for umbrellas, imitation jewellery, electrical and electronic items (loudspeaker and headphones), solar cells and modules and there are reduction in rates for ferrous waste and scrap, specified fabrics and garments, stainless steel, methyl alcohol and acetic acid. The key rate revisions are summarised in the below table. The Customs duty rate structure on capital goods and project imports has also been comprehensively reviewed and exemption on capital goods/project imports are being phased out in a gradual manner for various sectors (like power, fertilisers, textiles, leather, footwear and food processing) and to be eventually taxed at $7.5 \%$. However, Customs duty exemptions for certain specialised machinery would continue. Graded import duty structure is also being notified to operationalise Phased Manufacturing Plan (PMP) for wearables, hearables and smart meters. A sunset clause is being stipulated as per section 25(4A) of the Customs Act, 1962 in respective of conditional exemption entries.

Also, as part of the exercise for simplification of the Customs tariff structure and to maintain the effective Basic Customs Duty rate (and applicable cesses) of certain items unchanged, it is proposed to make suitable amendments in the Customs Tariff Act, 1975 effective 1 May 2022 by suitably omitting corresponding entries on respective exemption/concessional notifications, prescribed currently.
